

CLEANING KIT COMPONENTS

1. CLEANING SOLUTIONS:

- Disinfectant Spray or Wipes: Essential for sanitizing high-touch areas such as doorknobs, light switches, and bathroom fixtures.
- Bleach
- Floor Cleaner (Natra Kleen/Green Clean/Clean max Disinfectant):
- Multi-purpose degreaser cleaner:
- Glass Cleaner: Specifically designed for streak-free cleaning of glass surfaces, mirrors, and windows.
- Washroom Cleaner: Specifically used for urinal and toilet bowls only.



2. CLEANING TOOLS, EQUIPMENT AND ACCESSORIES

- Microfiber Cloths:
Ideal for dusting, wiping down surfaces, and polishing.



- Backpack Vacuum cleaner:
Notes:
 - Dust container needs to be emptied once a day.
 - Request for paper vacuum bags



- Sponges or Scrub Brushes:
Use sponges for general cleaning and scrub brushes for tougher stains.



- Rubber Gloves:
Protect hands from chemicals and potential skin irritation.



- Broom and Dustpan:
Essential for sweeping debris from floors.



- Bin Bags (Small 36L and Medium 54L):
Dispose of waste properly and maintain cleanliness.

4. STORAGE AND ORGANIZATION



- **Cleaning Caddy or Box:**
Assemble a portable container to hold all cleaning supplies. This looks more professional.



- **Storage Box (for the cars):**
Store larger equipment and additional supplies neatly.

TRAINING GUIDELINES

- **Safety First**
Emphasize the importance of using personal protective equipment (PPE) during cleaning tasks.
Familiarize participants with safety data sheets (SDS) for all cleaning chemicals.

Product Usage and Maintenance

Dilute the proper concentration for the cleaning products.
